- Introduction/Background/Objective
- Literature Review
- Methodology, Findings, Analysis & Discussion
- Conclusion, Limitations and Recommendations
- References – Harvard or APA Style is required
- Tables, figures, etc. in their appropriate location in the paper (if applicable)
- Margins: 1 inch or 2.5 cm.
- Font: Times New Roman/ Kruti Dev 011 (12 Size)
- Spacing: 1.5 between lines and 2 between paragraphs
